

Evolves from Mysterious Fossil Put Aerodactyl on the Basic Pokémon

Aerodactyl 60 HP

Fossil Pokémon. Length: 5' 11", Weight: 130 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Prehistoric Power No more Evolution cards can be played. This power stops working while Aerodactyl is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Wing Attack 30

weakness resistance retreat cost

A ferocious prehistoric Pokémon that goes for the enemy's throat with its serrated saw-like fangs. LV. 28 #142

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Basic Pokémon

Articuno 70 HP

Freeze Pokémon. Length: 5' 7", Weight: 122 lbs.

Freeze Dry Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed.

Blizzard Flip a coin. If heads, this attack does 10 damage to each of your opponent's Bench Pokémon. If tails, this attack does 10 damage to each of your own Bench Pokémon. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.)

High Jump Kick 50

weakness resistance retreat cost

A legendary bird Pokémon that is said to appear to doomed people who are lost in icy mountains. LV. 35 #144

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Basic Pokémon

Ditto 50 HP

Transform Pokémon. Length: 1' 0", Weight: 9 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Transform If Ditto is your Active Pokémon, treat it as if it were the same card as the Defending Pokémon, including type, Hit Points, Weakness, and so on, except Ditto can't evolve. Always has this Pokémon Power, and you may treat any Energy attached to Ditto as Energy of any type. Ditto isn't a copy of any other Pokémon while Ditto is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Slam Flip 2 coins. This attack does 40 damage times the number of heads.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Capable of copying an enemy's genetic code to instantly transform itself into a duplicate of the enemy. LV. 20 #132

Evolves from Dragonair Put Dragonite on the Stage 1 card

Dragonite 100 HP

Dragon Pokémon. Length: 7' 3", Weight: 463 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Step In Once during your turn (before your attack), if Dragonite is on your Bench, you may switch it with your Active Pokémon.

Slam Flip 2 coins. This attack does 40 damage times the number of heads.

weakness resistance retreat cost

An extremely rarely seen marine Pokémon. Its intelligence is said to match that of humans. LV. 45 #149

Evolves from Haunter Put Gengar on the Stage 1 card

Gengar 80 HP

Shadow Pokémon. Length: 4' 11", Weight: 89 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Curse Once during your turn (before your attack), you may move 1 damage counter from 1 of your opponent's Pokémon to another (even if it would Knock Out the other Pokémon). This power can't be used if Gengar is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Dark Mind If your opponent has any Bench Pokémon, choose 1 of them and this attack does 10 damage to it. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.)

Confuse Ray Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Confused.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Under a full moon, this Pokémon likes to mimic the shadows of people and laugh at their fright. LV. 38 #154

Evolves from Gasty Put Haunter on the Basic Pokémon

Haunter 50 HP

Gas Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 0.2 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Transparency Whenever an attack does anything to Haunter, flip a coin. If heads, prevent all effects of that attack, including damage, done to Haunter. This power stops working while Haunter is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Nightmare The Defending Pokémon is now Asleep.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Because of its ability to slip through black walls, it is said to be from another dimension. LV. 17 #193

Basic Pokémon

Hitmonlee 60 HP

Kicking Pokémon. Length: 4' 11", Weight: 110 lbs.

Stretch Kick If your opponent has any Bench Pokémon, choose 1 of them and this attack does 20 damage to it. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.)

High Jump Kick 50

weakness resistance retreat cost

When in a hurry, its legs lengthen progressively. It runs smoothly with extra long, leaping strides. LV. 30 #106

Evolves from Drowzee Put Hypno on the Basic Pokémon

Hypno 90 HP

Hypnosis Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 167 lbs.

Prophecy Look at up to 3 cards from the top of either player's deck and rearrange them as you like.

Dark Mind If your opponent has any Bench Pokémon, choose 1 of them and this attack does 10 damage to it. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.)

Slam Flip 2 coins. This attack does 40 damage times the number of heads.

weakness resistance retreat cost

When it locks eyes with an enemy, it will use a mix of psi moves such as Hypnosis and Confusion. LV. 38 #197

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Evolves from Kabuto Put Kabutops on the Stage 1 card

Kabutops 60 HP

Shellfish Pokémon. Length: 4' 3", Weight: 89 lbs.

Sharp Sickle 30

Absorb Remove a number of damage counters from Kabutops equal to half the damage done to the Defending Pokémon (after applying Weakness and Resistance) (rounded up to the nearest 10). If Kabutops has fewer damage counters than that, remove all of them.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Its sleek shape is perfect for swimming. It slashes prey with its claws and drains the body fluids. LV. 30 #141

Basic Pokémon

Lapras 80 HP

Transport Pokémon. Length: 8' 2", Weight: 485 lbs.

Water Gun Does 10 damage plus 10 more damage for each ♣ Energy attached to Lapras but not used to pay for this attack's Energy cost. You can't add more than 20 damage in this way.

Confuse Ray Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Confused.

weakness resistance retreat cost

A Pokémon that has been overheard almost to extinction. It can ferry people across water. LV. 31 #121

Evolves from Magnetite Put Magneton on the Basic Pokémon

Magneton 80 HP

Magnet Pokémon. Length: 3' 3", Weight: 132 lbs.

Sonicboom Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for this attack. (Any other effects that would happen after applying Weakness and Resistance still happen.)

Selfdestruct Does 20 damage to each Pokémon on each player's Bench. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Magneton does 100 damage to itself.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Formed by several Magnetites linked together. They frequently appear when storms flare up. LV. 35 #162

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Basic Pokémon

Moltres 70 HP

Flame Pokémon. Length: 4' 7", Weight: 132 lbs.

Wildfire You may discard any number of Energy cards attached to Moltres when you use this attack. If you do, discard that many cards from the top of your opponent's deck.

Dive Bomb Flip a coin. If tails, this attack does nothing.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Known as the legendary bird of fire. Every flap of its wings creates a deadly blast of flames. LV. 31 #148

Evolves from Grimer Put Muk on the Basic Pokémon

Muk 70 HP

Sludge Pokémon. Length: 3' 11", Weight: 66 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Toxic Gas Ignore all Pokémon Powers other than Toxic Gases. This power stops working while Muk is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Sludge Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Thickly covered with a filthy, white sludge. It is so toxic, even its footprints contaminate poison. LV. 34 #107

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Evolves from Rachiou Put Raichu on the Basic Pokémon

Raichu 90 HP

Mouse Pokémon. Length: 2' 7", Weight: 66 lbs.

Gigashock Choose 3 of your opponent's Bench Pokémon and this attack does 10 damage to each of them. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) If your opponent has fewer than 3 Bench Pokémon, do the damage to each of them.

weakness resistance retreat cost

Its long tail serves as a ground to protect itself from its own high-voltage power. LV. 45 #124

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Basic Pokémon

Zapdos 80 HP

Electric Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 116 lbs.

Thunderstorm For each of your opponent's Bench Pokémon, flip a coin. If heads, this attack does 20 damage to that Pokémon. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Then, Zapdos does 10 damage times the number of tails to itself.

weakness resistance retreat cost

A legendary thunderbird Pokémon whose anger is said to cause storms. Some say it has lived above the clouds for thousands of years. LV. 40 #145

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Slam Flip 2 coins. This attack does 40 damage times the number of heads.

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Capable of copying an enemy's genetic code to instantly transform itself into a duplicate of the enemy. LV. 20 #132

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Shadow Pokémon. Length: 4' 11", Weight: 89 lbs.

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Dark Mind If your opponent has any Bench Pokémon, choose 1 of them and this attack does 10 damage to it. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.)

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Haunter 50 HP

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Evolves from Kabuto Put Kabutops on the Stage 1 card

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Shellfish Pokémon. Length: 4' 3", Weight: 89 lbs.

Sharp Sickle 30

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Lapras 80 HP

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Evolves from Magnetite Put Magnetite on the Basic Pokémon

Magnetron 80 HP

Magnet Pokémon. Length: 3' 3", Weight: 132 lbs.

Sonicboom Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for this attack. (Any other effects that would happen after applying Weakness and Resistance still happen.) 20

Selfdestruct Does 20 damage to each Pokémon on each player's Bench. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Magnetron does 100 damage to itself. 100

weakness resistance retreat cost

Formed by several Magnetites linked together. They frequently appear when sunspots flow up. LV. 35 #182

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Basic Pokémon

Moltres 70 HP

Flame Pokémon. Length: 6' 7", Weight: 132 lbs.

Wildfire You may discard any number of Energy cards attached to Moltres when you use this attack. If you do, discard that many cards from the top of your opponent's deck.

Dive Bomb Flip a coin. If tails, this attack does nothing. 80

weakness resistance retreat cost

Known as the legendary bird of fire. Every flap of its wings creates a dazzling flash of flames. LV. 35 #146

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Evolves from Grimer Put Muk on the Basic Pokémon

Muk 70 HP

Sludge Pokémon. Length: 3' 11", Weight: 66 lbs.

Poison Power: Toxic Gas Ignore all Pokémon Powers other than Toxic Gas. This power stops working while Muk is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Sludge Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned. 30

weakness resistance retreat cost

Thickly covered with a filthy, vile sludge, it is so toxic, even its footprints contain poison. LV. 34 #89

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Evolves from Pichu Put Raichu on the Basic Pokémon

Raichu 90 HP

Mouse Pokémon. Length: 2' 7", Weight: 66 lbs.

Gigashock Choose 3 of your opponent's Bench Pokémon and this attack does 10 damage to each of them. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) If your opponent has fewer than 3 Bench Pokémon, do the damage to each of them. 30

weakness resistance retreat cost

Its long tail serves as a ground to protect itself from its own high voltage power. LV. 45 #86

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Basic Pokémon

Zapdos 80 HP

Electric Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 116 lbs.

Thunderstorm For each of your opponent's Bench Pokémon, flip a coin. If heads, this attack does 20 damage to that Pokémon. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Then, Zapdos does 10 damage times the number of tails to itself. 40

weakness resistance retreat cost

A legendary thunderbird Pokémon whose anger is said to cause storms. Some say it has lived above the clouds for thousands of years. LV. 40 #145

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Evolves from Ekans Put Arbok on the Basic Pokémon

Arbok 60 HP

Cobra Pokémon. Length: 11' 4", Weight: 143 lbs.

Terror Strike Flip a coin. If heads, and if your opponent has any Bench Pokémon, he or she chooses 1 of them and switches it with the Defending Pokémon. (Do the damage before switching the Pokémon.) 10

Poison Fang The Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

It is rumored that the ferocious warning markings on its belly differ from area to area. LV. 27 #124

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Evolves from Shellder Put Cloyster on the Basic Pokémon

Cloyster 50 HP

Bivalve Pokémon. Length: 4' 11", Weight: 292 lbs.

Clamp Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. If tails, this attack does nothing (not even damage). 30

Spike Cannon Flip 2 coins. This attack does 30 damage times the number of heads. 30x

weakness resistance retreat cost

When attacked, it launches its horns in quick volleys. Its intinals have never been seen. LV. 25 #91

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Basic Pokémon

Gastly 50 HP

Gas Pokémon. Length: 4' 3", Weight: 0.2 lbs.

Lick Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. 10

Energy Conversion Put up to 2 Energy cards from your discard pile into your hand. Gastly does 10 damage to itself.

weakness resistance retreat cost

A mysterious Pokémon. Some say it is a lifeform from another dimension, while others believe it is formed from strog. LV. 17 #92

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Evolves from Zubat Put Golbat on the Basic Pokémon

Golbat 60 HP

Bat Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 121 lbs.

Wing Attack 30

Leech Life Remove a number of damage counters from Golbat equal to the damage done to the Defending Pokémon (after applying Weakness and Resistance). If Golbat has fewer damage counters than that, remove all of them. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

Once it strikes, it will not stop draining energy from the victim even if it gets too heavy to fly. LV. 29 #82

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Evolves from Psyduck Put Golduck on the Basic Pokémon

Golduck 70 HP

Duck Pokémon. Length: 5' 7", Weight: 169 lbs.

Psychoshock Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. 10

Hyper Beam If the Defending Pokémon has any Energy cards attached to it, choose 1 of them and discard it. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

Often seen swimming elegantly by lake shores. It is often mistaken for the Japanese monster, Kappa. LV. 27 #163

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Evolves from Graveler Put Golem on the Stage 1 card

Golem 80 HP

Megaton Pokémon. Length: 4' 7", Weight: 662 lbs.

Avalanche 60

Selfdestruct Does 20 damage to each Pokémon on each player's Bench. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Golem does 100 damage to itself. 100

weakness resistance retreat cost

Its boulder-like body is extremely hard. It can easily withstand dynamite blasts without damage. LV. 36 #174

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Evolves from Geodude Put Graveler on the Basic Pokémon

Graveler 60 HP

Rock Pokémon. Length: 3' 3", Weight: 132 lbs.

Harden During your opponent's next turn, whenever 30 or less damage is done to Graveler (after applying Weakness and Resistance), prevent that damage. (Any other effects of attacks still happen.)

Rock Throw 40

weakness resistance retreat cost

Rolls down slopes to move. It rolls over any obstacle without slowing or changing its direction. LV. 29 #71

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Evolves from Kriaby Put Kingler on the Basic Pokémon

Kingler 60 HP

Pincer Pokémon. Length: 4' 3", Weight: 132 lbs.

Flail Does 10 damage times the number of damage counters on Kingler. 10x

Crabhammer 40

weakness resistance retreat cost

The large pincer has 10,000 horsepower of crushing power. However, its huge size makes it unreliable to use. LV. 27 #97

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Basic Pokémon

Magmar 70 HP

Spitfire Pokémon. Length: 4' 3", Weight: 98 lbs.

Smokescreen If the Defending Pokémon tries to attack during your opponent's next turn, your opponent flips a coin. If tails, that attack does nothing. 10

Smog Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

Found at the mouths of volcanoes and extremely hard to spot. There are very few instances of capturing the Pokémon. LV. 31 #174

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Evolves from Omastar Put Omastar on the Basic Pokémon

Omastar 70 HP

Spiral Pokémon. Length: 3' 3", Weight: 77 lbs.

Water Gun Does 30 damage plus 10 more damage for each Energy attached to Omastar but not used to pay for this attack's Energy cost. You can't add more than 20 damage in this way. 20+

Spike Cannon Flip 2 coins. This attack does 30 damage times the number of heads. 30x

weakness resistance retreat cost

A prehistoric Pokémon that died out when a huge comet made it impossible for it to catch prey. LV. 32 #119

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Evolves from Sandshrew Put Sandslash on the Basic Pokémon

Sandslash 70 HP

Mouse Pokémon. Length: 3' 3", Weight: 65 lbs.

Slash 20

Fury Swipes Flip 3 coins. This attack does 20 damage times the number of heads. 20x

weakness resistance retreat cost

Curled up into a spiny ball when threatened. It can roll while curled up to attack or escape. LV. 33 #118

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Evolves from Horsea Put Seadra on the Basic Pokémon

Seadra 60 HP

Dragon Pokémon. Length: 3' 11", Weight: 55 lbs.

Water Gun Does 30 damage plus 10 more damage for each Energy attached to Seadra but not used to pay for this attack's Energy cost. You can't add more than 20 damage in this way. 20+

Agility Flip a coin. If heads, during your opponent's next turn, prevent all effects of attacks, including damage, done to Seadra. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

Capable of swimming backward by rapidly flapping its wing-like pectoral fins and stout tail. LV. 24 #117

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Evolves from Slowpoke Put Slowbro on the Basic Pokémon

Slowbro 60 HP

Hermit crab Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 173 lbs.

Poison Power: Strange Behavior As often as you like during your turn (before your attack), you may move 1 damage counter from 1 of your Pokémon to Slowbro as long as you don't Knock Out Slowbro. This power can be used if Slowbro is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Psychoshock Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

The Shellder that is latched onto Slowpoke's tail is said to feed on the host's left-over scraps. LV. 26 #80

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Evolves from Tentacool Put Tentacruel on the Basic Pokémon

Tentacruel 60 HP

Jellyfish Pokémon. Length: 5' 3", Weight: 121 lbs.

Supersonic Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Confused. 10

Jellyfish Sting The Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned. 10

weakness resistance retreat cost

The tentacles are normally kept short. On hints, they are extended to ensnare and immobilize prey. LV. 31 #171

Evolves from Koffing Put Weezing on the Basic Pokémon

Weezing 60 HP

Poison Gas Pokémon. Length: 3' 11", Weight: 21 lbs.

Smog Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned. 20

Selfdestruct Does 10 damage to each Pokémon on each player's Bench. (Don't apply Weakness and Resistance for Bench Pokémon.) Weezing does 60 damage to itself. 60

weakness resistance retreat cost

Where two kinds of poison gases meet, two Koffings can fuse into a Weezing over many years. LV. 27 #111

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Basic Pokémon

Ekans 40 HP

Snake Pokémon. Length: 6' 7", Weight: 15 lbs.

Spit Poison Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Poisoned.

Wrap Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

Moves silently and stealthily. Eats the eggs of birds such as Pidgey and Spearow while they are asleep. LV. 10 #12

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Basic Pokémon

Geodude 50 HP

Rock Pokémon. Length: 1' 4", Weight: 44 lbs.

Stone Barrage Flip a coin until you get tails. This attack does 10 damage times the number of heads. 10x

weakness resistance retreat cost

Found in fields and mountains. Mistaking them for boulders, people often stop or trip on them. LV. 10 #74

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Basic Pokémon

Grimer 50 HP

Sludge Pokémon. Length: 2' 11", Weight: 66 lbs.

Nasty Goo Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Paralyzed. 10

Minimize All damage done by attacks to Grimer during your opponent's next turn is reduced by 20 (after applying Weakness and Resistance).

weakness resistance retreat cost

Appears in filthy areas. Forces by sucking up polluted sludge that is pumped out of factories. LV. 19 #88

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Basic Pokémon

Horsea 40 HP

Dragon Pokémon. Length: 1' 4", Weight: 18 lbs.

Smokescreen If the Defending Pokémon tries to attack during your opponent's next turn, your opponent flips a coin. If tails, that attack does nothing. 10

weakness resistance retreat cost

Known to shoot down flying bugs with precision blasts of ink from the surface of the water. LV. 19 #116

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Evolves from Mysterious Fossil Put Kabuto on the Basic Pokémon

Kabuto 30 HP

Shellfish Pokémon. Length: 1' 8", Weight: 25 lbs.

Poison Power: Kabuto Armor Whenever an attack (even your own) does damage to Kabuto (after applying Weakness and Resistance), that attack only does the least 10 damage to Kabuto (rounded down to the nearest 10). (Any other effects of attacks still happen.) This power stops working while Kabuto is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Scratch 10

weakness resistance retreat cost

A Pokémon that was resurrected from a fossil found in what was once the ocean floor eons ago. LV. 9 #140

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Basic Pokémon
Krabby 50 HP



River Crab Pokémon. Length: 1' 4", Weight: 14 lbs.

Call for Family Search your deck for a Basic Pokémon named Krabby and put it onto your Bench. Shuffle your deck afterward. (You can't use this attack if your Bench is full.)

Irongrip 20

weakness resistance retreat cost

No pinchers are not only powerful weapons, they are used for balance when walking sideways. LV.10 - 874

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Evolve from Mysterious Fossil For Omanyte into the Basic Pokémon
Omanyte 40 HP



Spiral Pokémon. Length: 1' 4", Weight: 17 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Clairvoyance Your opponent plays with his or her hand face up. This power stops working while Omanyte is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Water Gun Does 10 damage plus 10 more damage for each Energy attached to Omanyte but not used to pay for this attack's Energy cost. (You can't use more than 20 damage in this way.)

10+

weakness resistance retreat cost

Although long extinct, in rare cases, it can be genetically resurrected from fossils. LV.19 - 873

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Basic Pokémon
Psyduck 50 HP



Duck Pokémon. Length: 2' 7", Weight: 43 lbs.

Headache Your opponent can't play Trainer cards during his or her next turn.

Fury Swipes Flip 3 coins. This attack does 10 damage times the number of heads.

10x

weakness resistance retreat cost

While hailing its enemies with its vacant look, this wily Pokémon will use psychokinetic powers. LV.11 - 875

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Basic Pokémon
Shellder 30 HP



Bivalve Pokémon. Length: 1' 0", Weight: 9 lbs.

Supersonic Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Confused.

Hide in Shell Flip a coin. If heads, prevent all damage done to Shellder during your opponent's next turn. (Any other effects of attacks still happen.)

weakness resistance retreat cost

Its hard shell repels any kind of attack. It is vulnerable only when its shell is open. LV.8 - 895

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Basic Pokémon
Slowpoke 50 HP



Dopey Pokémon. Length: 3' 11", Weight: 79 lbs.

Spacing Out Flip a coin. If heads, remove a damage counter from Slowpoke. This attack can't be used if Slowpoke has no damage counters on it.

Incredibly slow and dopey, it takes 5 seconds for it to feel pain when under attack. LV.18 - 879

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Basic Pokémon
Tentacool 30 HP



Jellyfish Pokémon. Length: 2' 11", Weight: 100 lbs.

Pokémon Power: Cowardice As any time during your turn (before your attack), you may return Tentacool to your hand. (Discard all cards attached to Tentacool.) This power can't be used the turn you put Tentacool into play or if Tentacool is Asleep, Confused, or Paralyzed.

Acid 10

weakness resistance retreat cost

Drifts in shallow seas. Anglers who hook them by accident are often punished by its stinging acid. LV.10 - 872

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Basic Pokémon
Zubat 40 HP



Bat Pokémon. Length: 2' 7", Weight: 17 lbs.

Supersonic Flip a coin. If heads, the Defending Pokémon is now Confused.

Leech Life Remove a number of damage counters from Zubat equal to the damage done to the Defending Pokémon (after applying Weakness and Resistance). If Zubat has fewer damage counters than that, remove all of them.

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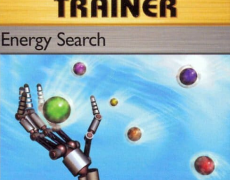

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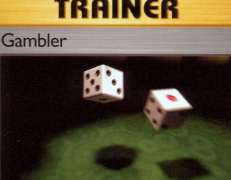

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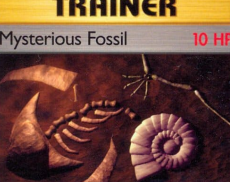

Play Mysterious Fossil as if it were a Basic Pokémon. While in play, Mysterious Fossil counts as a Pokémon (instead of a Trainer card). Mysterious Fossil has no attacks, can't retreat, and can't be Asleep, Confused, Paralyzed, or Poisoned. If Mysterious Fossil is Knocked Out, it doesn't count as a Knocked Out Pokémon. (Discard it anyway.) At any time during your turn before your attack, you may discard Mysterious Fossil from play.

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
